SUBJECT: PUBLIC WORKS PROGRAM UPDATES

Circle Park Driveway Project

The project entailed converting the dirt parking lot at Circle Park into a fully improved paved one. Construction is complete. The new parking lot features 12 new parking spaces, ADA accessibility, a new drive approach and permeable pavers. The contractor completed the punch list items and City staff will be working to finalize and accept the project.



Main Street Area Main Replacement

Golden State Water Company is installing a new 8-inch water main and 3 fire hydrants on Main Street between Pennsylvania Avenue and east of Garfield Avenue. City staff will be working with the contractor and perform the inspections. Construction is expected to be completed on the last week of October 2019.




Citywide Sidewalk Improvement Project, Phase VI

The Citywide Sidewalk Improvement Project, Phase VI is being implemented to enhance pedestrian mobility through a series of concrete repairs. The project includes removal and reconstruction of sidewalks, curb and gutters, wheelchair ramps, driveway approaches, tree/stump removal, and root barriers. The project was advertised in October 2019.




Soundwalls on Frontage Road

The bid opening for the construction of the two soundwall sections along Frontage Road was held at the City Clerk's office on Tuesday, September 10, 2019. The City received a total of three (3) bids. Staff is currently analyzing the lowest bid and contacting the contractor's references. It is anticipated that construction of the soundwalls will start in January 2020.



Parque Dos Rios

The construction phase, of a new park for wild life known as the Parque Dos Rios, has begun. This project is a collaborative effort between the Water Conservation Authority and the City that will create a natural area for wildlife along the Los Angeles River. When completed, the park will include bike amenities, a seating area and planted native vegetation. Construction is scheduled to take 5 months to complete.



Miller Way & Frontage Road Pressure Main Upgrade Project

Southern California Gas Company is replacing over 2,200 linear feet of 4" main with a 6" main to increase capacity of their service. The work is being done along Miller Way from Miller Way to Garfield Avenue and Frontage Road from Miller Way to Southern Avenue. Construction is planned for completion in October 2019.
