A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SOUTH GATE SERVING AS SUCCESSOR AGENCY TO THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF SOUTH GATE APPROVING THE RECOGNIZED OBLIGATION PAYMENT SCHEDULE FOR THE 13-14B SIX-MONTH FISCAL PERIOD OF JANUARY 1, 2014 TO JUNE 30, 2014, SUBJECT TO SUBMITTAL TO, AND REVIEW BY THE OVERSIGHT BOARD AND THE DOF PURSUANT TO CALIFORNIA HEALTH AND SAFETY CODE, DIVISION 24, PART 1.85, AS AMENDED BY ASSEMBLY BILL 1484; AUTHORIZE POSTING AND TRANSMITTAL THEREOF

WHEREAS, the Community Development Commission of the City of South Gate ("former Agency") previously was a public body, corporate and politic formed, organized, existing and exercising its powers pursuant to Section 34100, *et seq.* of the California Health and Safety Code, and exercised the powers, authority, functions, jurisdiction of a community redevelopment agency formed, organized, existing and exercising its powers pursuant to the California Community Redevelopment Law, Health and Safety Code, Section 33000, *et seq.*, and specifically formed by the City Council ("City Council") of the City of South Gate ("City"); and

WHEREAS, Assembly Bill x1 26 chaptered and effective on June 27, 2011 added Parts 1.8 and 1.85 to Division 24 of the California Health & Safety Code, which caused the dissolution of all redevelopment agencies and wind down of the affairs of former agencies, including as such laws were amended by Assembly Bill 1484 chaptered and effective on June 27, 2012 (together, the "Dissolution Act"); and

WHEREAS, as of February 1, 2012 the Agency was dissolved pursuant to the Dissolution Act, and as a separate public entity, corporate and politic the Successor Agency to the Community Development Commission of the City of South Gate ("Successor Agency") administers the enforceable obligations of the former Agency and otherwise unwinds the former Agency's affairs, all subject to the review and approval by a seven-member oversight board ("Oversight Board"); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 34179 the Successor Agency's Oversight Board has been formed and its initial meeting occurred on April 23, 2012; and

WHEREAS, Section 34179 provides that the Oversight Board has fiduciary responsibilities to holders of enforceable obligations and the taxing entities that benefit from distributions of property tax and other revenues pursuant to Section 34188 of Part 1.85 of the Dissolution Act; and

WHEREAS, Sections 34177(m), and 34179 provide that each ROPS is submitted to reviewed and approved by the Successor Agency and then reviewed and approved by the Oversight Board before final review and approval by the State Department of Finance (“DOF”); and

WHEREAS, Section 34177(m) of the Dissolution Act requires that the ROPS for the 13-14B six-month fiscal period of January 1, 2014 to June 30, 2014 (“ROPS 13-14B”) shall be submitted to the DOF by the successor agency, after approval by the oversight board, no later than October 1, 2013; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Sections 34179.6 and 34177(k)(2)(B) of the Dissolution Act, the Successor Agency is required to submit a copy of the draft ROPS 13-14B to the County Administrative Officer (“CAO”), the County Auditor-Controller (“CAC”), the State Controller’s Office (“SCO”) and the DOF at the same time that the Successor Agency submits such draft ROPS to the Oversight Board for review; and

WHEREAS, the Successor Agency has reviewed the draft ROPS 13-14B and desires to approve the ROPS 13-14B and to authorize the Successor Agency, to transmit the such ROPS to the Oversight Board; and

WHEREAS, the Successor Agency shall post the ROPS 13-14B on the Successor Agency website;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL SERVING AS THE SUCCESSOR AGENCY DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The foregoing recitals are incorporated into this Resolution by this reference, and constitute a material part of this Resolution.

SECTION 2. Pursuant to the Dissolution Act, the Successor Agency approves the ROPS 13-14B submitted herewith as Attachment 1 and incorporated by this reference; provided however, that the ROPS 13-14B is approved subject to the condition such ROPS 13-14B is to be transmitted to the Oversight Board for review and approval and a copy of such draft ROPS 13-14B also concurrently be sent to the CAO, CAC, SCO, and DOF. Further, the Assistant City Manager/Finance Director, in consultation with legal counsel, shall be authorized to request and complete meet and confer session(s) with the DOF and authorized to make augmentations, modifications, additions or revisions as may be necessary or directed by DOF, and changes, if any, will be reported back to the Successor Agency and the Oversight Board.

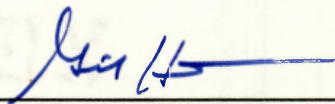
SECTION 3. After approval by the Oversight Board, the Successor Agency authorizes transmittal of the ROPS 13-14B again to the CAC, SCO and DOF.

SECTION 4. The Assistant City Manager/Finance Director of the Successor Agency or an authorized designee is directed to post this Resolution, including the ROPS 13-14B, on the Successor Agency website pursuant to the Dissolution Act.

SECTION 5. The City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of this Resolution which shall be effective upon its adoption.

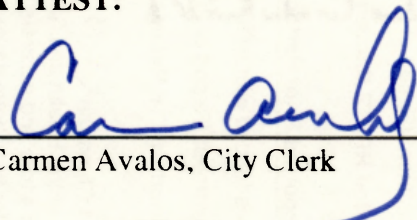

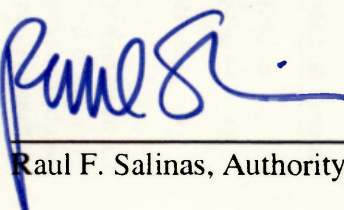
