

SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM



ENERGIZING OUR FUTURE

SoCalGas® believes that a well-educated workforce makes good business sense and is essential for a vital and economically healthy Southern California.

The program is open to high school graduating seniors and transferring community college students in the SoCalGas service territory who will be attending a vocational/technical school or a two-year or four-year college or university.

Scholarships of \$1,000 will be awarded to selected graduating high school students attending a vocational/technical school or community college. Transferring community college students and high school graduates attending an accredited four-year college or university are eligible for a \$5,000 scholarship.



APPLICANT ELIGIBILITY

1. Applicants must be graduating seniors of an accredited public or private high school, or community college students transferring to a four-year college or university.
2. Students must enroll full-time beginning the fall semester of the current year.
3. Students must have an overall grade point average of at least 3.0.
4. Applicants must have demonstrated strong community involvement.
5. Applicants must have a demonstrated financial need.
6. Students majoring in engineering, business, accounting and math will be given priority, but students majoring in other fields are not excluded from applying.
7. Children or dependents of elected or appointed local, county and state officials are not eligible.
8. Children or dependents of employees of SoCalGas or any other Sempra Energy company are not eligible.

SELECTION AND VERIFICATION PROCESS

Representatives of SoCalGas throughout Southern California work with their communities and local organizations to identify and select scholarship recipients. SoCalGas has the final responsibility for selecting recipients, and decisions of SoCalGas are final.

The scholarship will be awarded for the fall semester or quarter of the current year, and it will be issued upon receipt of verification of full-time enrollment. Verification is due and must be received as soon as a student is enrolled, and in any event not later than August 1st (postmarks not accepted).

Awards will be issued through an independent scholarship administrator and mailed directly to students. The scholarship administrator will follow up with scholarship recipients to provide additional information regarding their awards.

Forfeiture of Awards

Students who do not complete the required information, who fail to submit verification of enrollment, who fail to enroll as full-time students or who fail to provide timely verification, may be required to forfeit their awards. Due to budget limitations, SoCalGas will not hold over or delay awards from one academic term to another.

PROGRAM LIMITS

1. SoCalGas reserves the right to change or terminate this program at any time, without notice.
2. SoCalGas is not responsible for lost applications, lost verification of enrollment or information or materials misplaced or delayed through the mail or other delivery processes.
3. Once submitted, all information and materials become the property of SoCalGas, and will not be returned. All information will be kept confidential in accordance with SoCalGas' standard business practice.

HOW TO APPLY

1. Carefully complete the application, listing all pertinent facts relating to your personal and academic achievements. Additional sheets of paper may be attached.
2. Request a copy of your official transcripts from your school. Official transcripts must be signed and embossed.
3. Enclose with your application a recent photo of yourself, such as your school photo, preferably a color head shot measuring at least 3x5 inches.
4. Return the completed application and all other information, including the official transcript and photo, to the SoCalGas representative listed on the application. Applications must be returned no later than April 15th unless, prior to such date, the applicant requests an extension in writing and SoCalGas approves such request in its sole discretion.
