CONSTRUCTION NOTICE FOR THE LONG BEACH BOULEVARD COMPLETE STREET IMPROVEMENT PROJECT, 515-ST AND 564-ST

Summary:

The Long Beach Boulevard Street Improvements Project is a part of the City's Capital Improvement Program. This multi-million investment aims to enhance safety, traffic circulation, rehabilitation, and beautification on Long Beach Boulevard, from Tweedy Boulevard to Santa Ana Street. Project improvements include pavement rehabilitation, installing raised, landscaped, and hardscaped medians, corridor pedestrian lighting, up-lighting, bike amenities, street trees, storm water quality features, sidewalk and bikeway improvements, bus stops and street furniture. The project is funded with local and federal grant funds.

Construction is scheduled to begin on September 11, 2023, and planned for completion in eight (8) months. Construction will take place from 8:00 AM to 4:00 PM. Construction activities include heavy equipment, traffic control, lane closures, and will temporarily impact parking. Some construction activities will impact noise levels, such as during concrete removals. Construction activities will be scheduled to minimize impacts, where feasible. Construction signage will be placed with sufficient time to provide information needed to accommodate parking conditions. The City's contractor, Sequel Contractors, Inc., will be issuing a notice of construction with more information and contact information.

What to Expect:

The City's goal is to minimize impacts to the community and ensure everyone's safety. Be on the lookout for construction signs. During construction, street parking will be prohibited intermittently as construction progresses. Street parking will remain available on side streets or next to the construction zone. Please adhere to No Parking/Tow Away Zones and all other traffic signs and notices.

Project Budget:

The total Project budget is \$10.6 million, which will be funded primarily with Federal, State and Local funds including ATPL grant, HSIP grant, Measure M, Prop C, Measure W, and TDA funds.
