Firestone Boulevard Regional Capacity Enhancement Project (THE BOULEVARD PROJECT, PHASE II)

Construction Alert Lane Closures:

August 14, 2023 to December 22, 2023


Construction of The Boulevard Project is well underway. The next area of construction is to widen the roadway at the Firestone Boulevard and California Avenue intersection. The contractor has begun the sawcut operation at the intersection. The work requires a temporary closure in the immediate area of work. This means all other travel lanes will remain open.

Work will be performed during nonpeak hours to minimize traffic impacts, from Monday, August 14 through Friday, December 22, 2023 from 8:00 AM to 4:00 PM.

During construction, street parking will be available on side streets or next to the construction zone. Please adhere to No Parking/Tow Away Zones and all other traffic signs and notices.

PLEASE ADHERE TO THE FOLLOWING SAFETY TIPS:

- Be patient and expect delays, especially during peak travel times.
- Slow down and watch for workers, heavy equipment, pedestrians and cyclists.
- Avoid mobile phone use when driving through the construction zone.
- Watch for lane closures, use alternate routes and follow detours.
- Do not climb or enter areas where crews are working or materials and equipment are stored.
- Remember, this is a short-term inconvenience for a long-term traffic solution.
