

What is the **GATEWAY DISTRICT?**

The **Gateway District** encompasses approximately 59 acres located at the north-east corner of Firestone Blvd and Atlantic Ave. It is:

- The future site of the planned South
 Gate Transit Station along the West
 Santa Ana Branch Corridor Transit Line.
- Identified to become a dense "transit village" designed to support a high-level of pedestrian activity.
- Envisioned as a visual and functional transit gateway feature for the City of South Gate.
- The optimal location for **future transit- oriented development** (TOD) to support the future transit station.
- Currently characterized by existing lightto heavy-industrial uses and emerging retail uses.



Conceptual Sketch of the Gateway District








Where are you COMING FROM OR GOING TO?








Where are you COMING FROM OR GOING TO?






Examples of TRANSIT PLAZAS
