City Improves Water System by **Installing New and Upgraded Amenities**

South Gate recognizes the importance of maintaining a state-of-the-art water system to continue to provide its residents and businesses with clean, clear,

drinking water that can safely be used inside the homes of residents and businesses. On January, the City Council awarded a construction contract to install a new reservoir to be called the Elizabeth Reservoir, as well as a new Water Well (No.29). This \$14.1 million dollar project will include the installation of various modern amenities that will significantly improve the reliability of the City's water system.



The installation of the Elizabeth Reservoir,

which will be able to store 1.8 million gallons of water, will be conducted at the Well No. 28 Site. In addition to the new reservoir, a new booster pump station and piping upgrades will be implemented. The site of the Santa Fe Water Tower, located at Santa Fe Avenue and Ardmore Avenue, will be home to various innovations such as the new water well and back-up generator, a diesel tank, a chlorination building, seismic retrofitting to the water tower, a booster pump, and a new administration building. Additionally, a unique and attractive logo will be placed on the Santa Fe Water Tower to welcome residents and visitors to the City.

The addition of this improved, state-of-the art water system will provide a better quality of life for South Gate residents and businesses by providing clean, clear, potable water to be used for everyday activities. Construction has begun and will be completed in August 2017.
