Shining a bright light on the Tweedy Mile Business District!

South Gate recognizes the connection between an aesthetically pleasing atmosphere and a flourishing business environment. In *light* of this, the City Council ap-



proved installation of decorative street tree lights on Tweedy Boulevard from State Street to Hunt Avenue; a corridor commonly known as the Tweedy Mile Business District! Construction is under way and will be completed in late November 2015.

By installing decorative street tree lighting on approximately 171 street trees, the City of South Gate (City) aims to enhance the visual appeal and attractiveness of the Tweedy Mile Business District and provide an inviting place that can attract new busi-

nesses and enhance a patron's shopping experience. The lights will enhance pedestrian experience and visual appeal of the district by creating a comfortable, attractive and walkable environment, inadvertently attracting more shoppers. The Tweedy Mile Tree Lighting Project will create an attractive environment that will evoke a sense of pride for South Gate residents and all who work and shop in the Tweedy Mile Shopping District.

Join the South Gate City Council for the official unveiling and lighting ceremony on Thursday, November 19th at 5pm on Tweedy Blvd., between San Antonio Avenue and San Carlos Avenue (street closure). The event will have live music, arts and crafts, free pumpkin pie, photobooth, and a free raffle to win gift cards to restaurants and stores on Tweedy Blvd.

South Gate Business Recognized by Senator Ricardo Lara

Glasswerks Inc. was awarded the Excellence in Business Award by Senator Ricardo Lara in recognition for their contributions to the community. Business Sign Permit Process

Are you a business owner and would like to obtain a sign permit? Follow these five simple steps:

> STEP 1 – Download the Sign Permit Application and Site Plan Sample at www.cityofsouthgate.org/Planning.

STEP 2 – Complete the application and draft three (3) copies of plans showing elevations, image of sign and site plan.

STEP 3 – Submit the application with three (3) copies of plans and payment of \$69 for design review to the Planning Division. The Planning Division will take approximately one (1) week to review your application, providing the application is complete and satisfies all requirements.

STEP 4 – After Planning Division approval, you will need structural and electrical approval from the Building & Safety Division. Submit two (2) sets of plans to the Building & Safety Division and pay the plan check fee based on the valuation of the sign(s). The Building & Safety Division will take approximately two (2) weeks to review your plans.

STEP 5 - Upon structural/electrical sign permit approval, the business owner's contractor must pick-up the permit and pay the fee balance. Sign permits are only issued to licensed contractors.

Please keep in mind that the following signs are prohibited: portable, folding, A-Frame, other similar type signs and roof signs. Temporary signs, such as banners and windows signs are only allowed for ninety (90) days.
