### CITY OF SOUTH GATE SPECIAL CITY COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES TUESDAY, MAY 14, 2019

CALL TO ORDER

Vice Mayor Denise Diaz called a Special City Council meeting to order at 5:30 p.m.

CLOSED SESSION

Nick Godoy, 8611 San Gabriel Avenue inquired about the amount of money that has been spent on the tree trimming law suit. Also, how many times these types of items come before the City Council.

City Attorney Salinas, stated that this is all part of public knowledge and explained that this case is regarding a tree that has fallen on the Torrez home. The Torrez family then filed a suit against the tree trimming company and also against the City of South Gate subsequently. The matter is before the City Council today because the City insisted that the tree trimmer be responsible for all damages. In closed session the City Council will receive a report regarding a proposed settlement that will resolve in payment to the City, not payment by the City in connection with that.

The Council Members recessed into Closed Session at 5:36 p.m. and reconvened at 6:40 p.m. with four Members of Council present. City Attorney Salinas reported the following:

Item 1 dealt with a series of cases under pending litigation and they all are related to a tree that had fallen on a house within the City of South Gate. In Closed Session the City Council received a report by the City Attorney and by City staff with respect to that litigation. There is a proposed settlement in which the City will be recovering the Attorney fees that were incurred in defense of the case and without having to pay any money out on settlement. The precise terms of the agreement are not being disclosed now because the agreement has not been fully executed, but it will be disclosed pursuant to the Brown Act once the agreement goes through. The City Council approved the proposed settlement by a motion made by Council Member Davila and seconded by Council Member Bernal with a vote of 4 to 0. This will include returning money back to the City's General Fund incurred in the prosecution and defense of these cases.
