**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOUTH GATE,  
AMENDING THE CITY'S CONFLICT OF INTEREST CODE FOR DESIGNATED  
CITY PERSONNEL, ADOPTING BY REFERENCE SECTION 18730 OF THE  
CALIFORNIA CODE OF REGULATIONS AND CONSULTANT CONFLICT OF  
INTEREST CODE QUESTIONNAIRE**

**WHEREAS**, the Political Reform Act (Codified in Government Code Section 81000, et seq.) requires state and local government agencies to adopt and promulgate conflict of interest codes; and

**WHEREAS**, the Fair Political Practices Commission has adopted a standard conflict of interest code, as set forth in Section 18730 of the California Code of Regulations (Section 18730); which can be incorporated by reference in a municipal code; and

**WHEREAS**, the City desires to incorporate by Section 18730 and any amendments to it as may be adopted by the Fair Political Practices Commission from time to time; and

**WHEREAS**, the City further desires that Section 18730, including the attached Appendix, establishing disclosure categories for certain officials and employees, shall constitute the conflict of interest code of the City of South Gate; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Resolution No. 7407, the City adopted an amended Conflict of Interest Code containing designated positions and disclosure categories and repealing Resolution No. 7283; and

**WHEREAS**, Government Code Section 87306.5 requires every local agency to review its conflict of interest code every even-numbered year to ensure it is up to date, meets the current legal requirements, and revise it if necessary; and

**WHEREAS**, City Attorney, City Clerk and staff have reviewed the current conflict of interest code, last amended in 2010, and have determined that it should be updated to reflect changes in city departments, and job duties and responsibilities of various city personnel required to file disclosure reports under California law; and;

**WHEREAS**, in accordance with regulation of the Fair Political Practices Commission, notice of a 45- day comment period was posted and ended on November 21, 2012 with no comments having been received on the City's amendments to the conflict of interest code; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOUTH GATE DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.** The City Council hereby adopts by reference Section 18730 of the California Code of Regulations as the City's conflict of interest code, including any amendments to it as may be adopted by the Fair Political Practices Commission from time to time. The City

further desires that Section 18730, including the attached Appendix "C", establishing disclosure categories for certain officials and employees, shall constitute the conflict of interest code of the City of South Gate. Accordingly, Resolution No. 7407, passed and adopted on December 14, 2012 is hereby amended by this resolution.

**Section 2.** The conflict of interest code adopted by this Resolution shall be applicable to the City Council, all specified positions in Government Code Section 87200 and designated positions set forth in the newly revised and adopted Appendix "A."

**Section 3.** The City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of this Resolution which shall be effective upon its adoption.




