CAMPAIGN FINANCE DISCLOSURES Presidential Primary/ GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION MARCH 3, 2020

All Candidates shall comply with filing requirements under FPPC guidelines:

- **Code of Fair Campaign Practices** - A voluntary statement pledging to subscribe to fair practices during the candidate's campaign for public office.
- **Form 700 - Statement of Economic Interests and Instructions** - Must be filed with this office upon pulling of nomination papers no later than December 6, 2019.
- **Form 501 - Candidate Intention Statement** - Must be filed with the Office of the City Clerk **before** you solicit or receive any contributions and is done for every single election.
- **Form 410 - Statement of Organization** - For use by Recipient Committees that receive \$1,000 or more in contributions during a calendar year. Must be filed with the Secretary of State's Office, with a copy sent to the Office of the Clerk's Office at the same time it is sent to the Secretary of State's Office.
- **Form 460 - Recipient Committee Campaign Statement** - For use by candidates filing jointly with his or her controlled committee(s).
- **Form 470 - Short Form Officeholder and Candidate Campaign Statement** - For use by candidates or officeholders who do not anticipate raising or spending \$1,000 or more in a calendar year.
- **Form 470S - Officeholder and Candidate Campaign Statement** - Form 470 Supplement for use by candidates/officeholders who have filed Form 470 and subsequently receive contributions totaling \$1,000 or make expenditures totaling \$1,000 or more during the calendar year.
- **Form 497** - Late Contribution/Expenditures are due within 24 hours of receiving \$1,000 and reporting begins 90 days prior to the election.
- **Campaign Disclosure Manual 2**- Provisions of the Political Reform Act prepared by the Fair Political Practices Commission.
