

**PUBLIC NOTICE CITY OF SOUTH GATE**  
**AVAILABILITY OF FUNDS AND REQUEST**  
**FOR PROPOSALS**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the City of South Gate is entitled to receive an estimated \$1,400,000 dollars in Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) for Fiscal Year 2023-2024. Of the total estimated amount, a maximum of fifteen percent (15%) or **approximately \$210,000** will be available to applicants for Public Service projects.

Proposed Public Service projects are required to *benefit low to moderate-income City residents* and meet a HUD eligible activity, including but not limited to those concerned with *crime prevention, childcare, health, drug abuse, education, fair housing counseling, senior services, youth at-risk assistance or recreational needs*. A complete list of the eligible activities is available at South Gate City Hall in the Housing Division of the Community Development Department or online at the *U.S Government Printing Office website*: [www.ecfr.gov](http://www.ecfr.gov), *Title 24 - CFR 570 –CDBG, Subpart C, §570.201(e)*.
